Orange Bike Brewing medals at 2025 World Beer Cup

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East Bayside gluten-free brewery Orange Bike Brewing recently won a silver medal at the 2025 World Beer Cup, the prestigious competition known as "the Olympics of beer."

Orange Bike earned the award in the gluten-free category for its winter lager. The Diamond Street brewery was the only brewery in Maine and just one of six in New England to medal at the international competition this year.

The 2025 World Beer Cup drew 8,375 entries from 1,761 breweries in 49 countries. The awards ceremony was held May 1 in Indianapolis.

In 2024, <u>Orange Bike won</u> a silver medal for its Oktoberfest beer and a bronze for its flagship pilsner in the gluten-free category at The Great American Beer Festival.
